Bookstore Intent to Sell

(For Nonprofit Organizations)

True Colors, an independent bookstore based in Minneapolis, Minn., runs the on-site conference bookstore located within the San Jose Convention Center. The standard percentage for the bookstore is 40%. As a courtesy to nonprofit organizations, this percentage has been reduced to 20%.

To register publications to be sold at the on-site NYLC Conference Bookstore:

1. Submit this form as an attachment to manager@truecolorsbookstore.com. This form must be received by February 29, 2010, and must be submitted in advance — whether you are carrying your books with you to San Jose, or shipping them ahead to True Colors Bookstore in Minneapolis.
2. Price books in an obvious place on the cover prior to shipping. Items not properly marked will not be sold.

Book Handling

Before the conference:

1. Label your boxes: NSLC, and send them, to arrive by March 8, to:

If books arrive after March 8, we will make every effort to process and transport them, but cannot guarantee they will make it to the conference.

2. Carry books to the conference yourself, and deliver them to the Convention Center — if you have sent ahead the Intent to Sell form. Bookstore set-up will begin at 9:00 a.m. Wed., March 24, and will continue until 3:30 p.m. that day. Please deliver them to the bookstore within that timeframe.

After the conference:

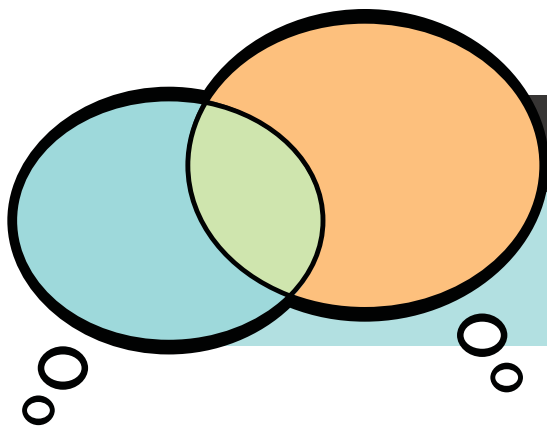
1. Books NOT sold by the end of the conference will be shipped to your agency, with shipping costs deducted from your profits.
2. Or you may take the merchandise with you after the store closes on Saturday, March 27 at 1:30 p.m.
Note: *Neither True Colors Bookstore nor NYLC is responsible for merchandise left in the Convention Center after show close Sat., March 27 at 1:30 p.m. if your form indicates you will be picking up your books at conference close.*

The bookstore can only pay for what is sold according to their records. Shoplifting can occur in any setting, and the bookstore cannot assume liability for these losses.

Publicity helps! The bookstore will accept purchase orders from organizations and schools. Please inform people within your network so they plan accordingly.
